"Flensburg on Patrol" aims to give guests an insight into the work of the Schleswig-Holstein Police and to highlight to young police officers the opportunities that membership in the IPA offers.

At the heart of the event is the creation and strengthening of international connections and friendships. The board of the IPA Branch Flensburg is currently developing a concept for a symposium that will particularly address young police officers and cover the following key topics:

Alcohol and drugs in road traffic

Public perception of the police

Accommodation:

Accommodation will be provided at the German Navy School in Flensburg. For accommodation, a nominal registration and a personal security check by the German Armed Forces are required.

Arrival:

By car: direct arrival at meeting point: 24937 Flensburg, Norderhofenden 1

By train: direct train connection from Denmark and Hamburg central station or Kiel central station

By plane: Hamburg Airport (HAM) or Billund Airport (BLL)

A pickup at Hamburg or Billund Airport will be ensured by IPA Branch Flensburg.

Condition for a participation

IPA members in active police service who are able to speak German and/or English are welcome to apply for „Flensburg on Patrol“ via the respective national section. Wearing a uniform on particular occasions is requested (see program).

Maximum number of participants: 16 (1 to 2 participants per section)

Maximum age of participants: 40 years old

Application deadline: 30st April 2026

The following services are provided by the hosting department:

- accomodation
- breakfast
- all trips, listed in the program, including entry fees
- a transfer from Flensburg's station as well as from Hamburg and Billund Airport

The following costs have to be covered by the respective section:

- trip to Flensburg
- all other costs, which haven't explicitly been listed (visa, travel insurance, etc., further meals)

All participants agree that pictures are taken and video recordings are made during the event. These will exclusively be used for advertising purposes of the IPA and the police department Flensburg.

All photographs and videos are made available to each participant. They are allowed to be used for IPA purposes, but not commercially.

If not all invited sections register participants, the remaining spots will be allocated by lottery among the participating sections. We therefore kindly ask you to let us know if there are any further interested participants from the sections. The remaining spots will be assigned shortly after the registration deadline.

If your section is willing to send one or two participants, let us know immediately so that we can make the necessary reservations.

- police unit
- officer in uniform yes/no
- passport copy
- police service card copy
